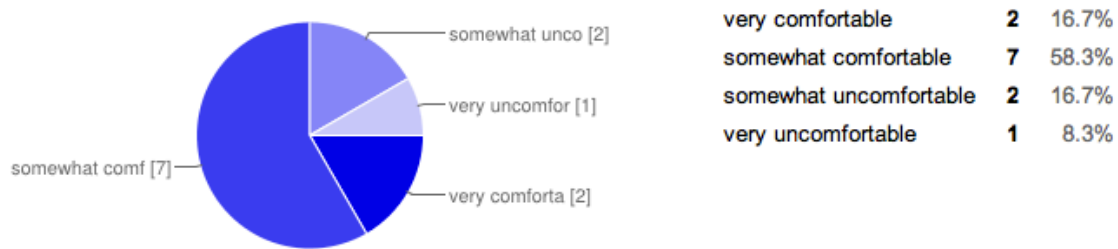
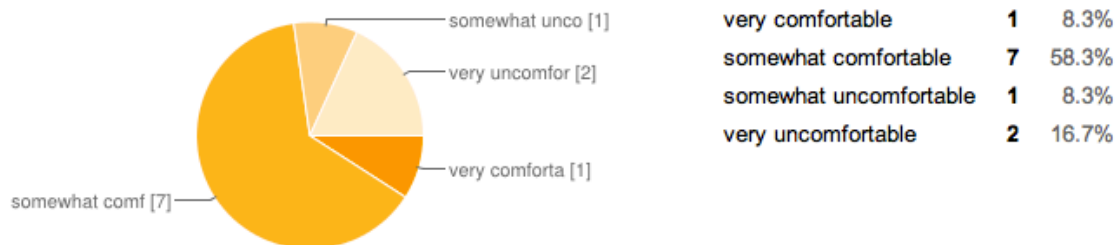


## Google Docs Workshop Evaluation
