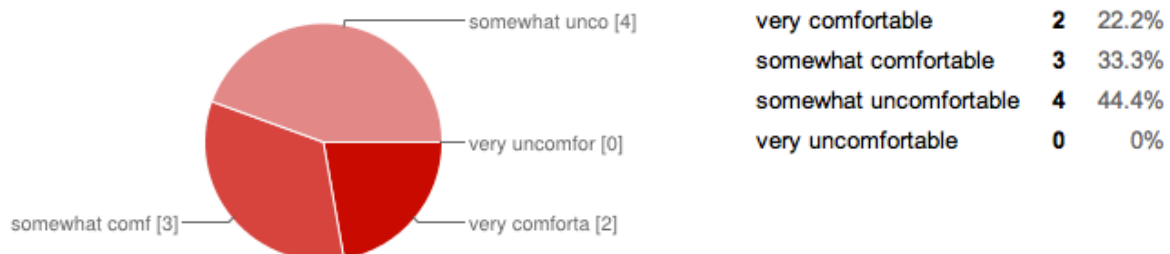
How comfortable are you with using Google Sheets to create a spreadsheet?
